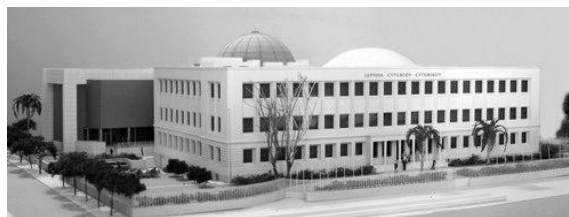

The inscription of Eleusis, was found by archeologist Philios on 1893 in the small town of Eleusis, which is located 15 Km west of Athens city. It has been inscribed on a white marble stele of dimensions 51cm height, 21cm width and 6cm thickness, around 360 B. C. At that time this inscription is considered, as the oldest ancient European standard discovered so far and constitutes a standard with very strict technical specifications, www.hsnt.gr/ndt-in-ancient-greece-by-i-n-prassianakis.
